

## Terms of Service - Residence Reservation System, Osaka University

1. This "Terms of Service" is used on Residence Reservation System (RRS) to apply for residences as described below:
  - 1) Toyonaka Campus International House
  - 2) Suita Campus International House
  - 3) International Student Dormitories

These are temporary residences for international students who newly enter Osaka University until they get used to live in Japan, and for international researchers and visitors who are in charge of education and research at Osaka University.
2. Only those who have been officially accepted by their faculty to Osaka University as an International Student or an International Researcher can make an application on RRS.
3. International student means someone who possesses a "college student" visa as a status of resident in Japan.
4. The application period is set for each residence, and applications before or after that period will not be accepted. Please see the outline of each residence for the application period.
5. Please refer to the outlines of each house and dormitory for the period of residence.

Furthermore, for those who are visiting Osaka University for research, and wish to stay at the Toyonaka Campus International House or the Suita Campus International House, it is possible to apply to stay for one more day before and one more day after the official period of their research while it is within the limits of the period of residence. However, one cannot move in or out of the accommodations on holidays, etc., which is further explained in point # 9.
6. The application is not completed until the completion screen appears. If you terminate the process or leave the screen for 30 minutes, the system will return to the top page, erasing any information that has been inputted.
7. Completion of application does not guarantee acceptance for entry into the residences.
8. The acceptance of applications will be decided in order of approval at each faculty.
9. [Only for International Students(Toyonaka International House and International Student Dormitories)]

Vacating or moving into the residences is not permitted on Saturday, Sunday, National holidays and during the university summer and winter holidays.
10. [Only for Researchers (Toyonaka and Suita International House)] Vacating or moving into the residences is permitted on Saturdays and Sundays, national holiday. (Except for the university summer and winter holiday)
11. In case of couple and family rooms, applicants are required to enter the residence, with family members whom you declared in the application, on the first date of the residency.
12. When it becomes clear that the application contents had falsehood, the application will be rejected. Acceptance will also be cancelled if false information has been detected after acceptance of the application.
